

John 20:31





We are also hiring assistant teachers. Our preschool is growing leaps and bounds. We now have 38 students registered for the fall. School begins on Wednesday, September 7.



Hopefully, you will be able to take advantage of some back-to-school sales. All items are due by Sunday, August 28.
